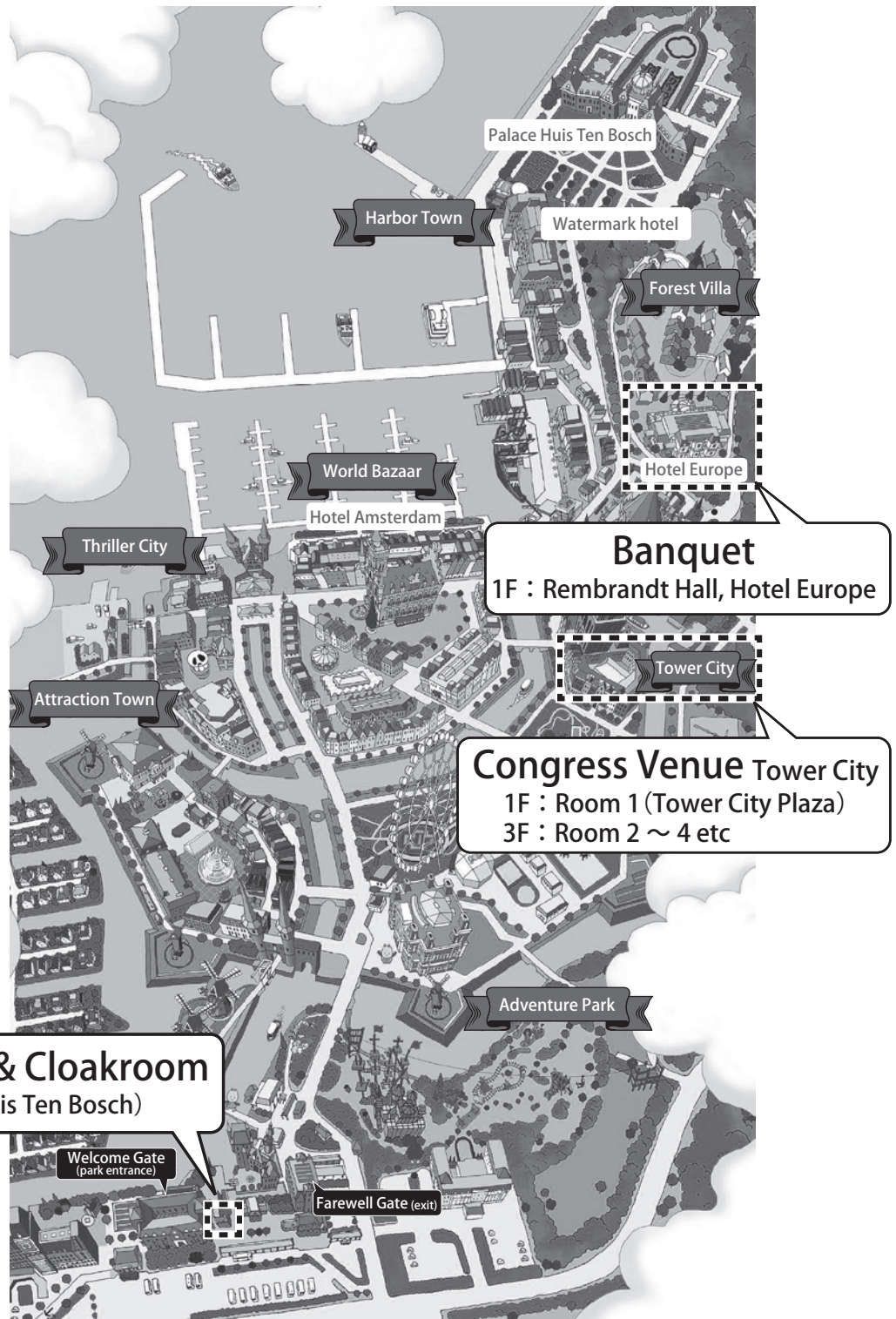

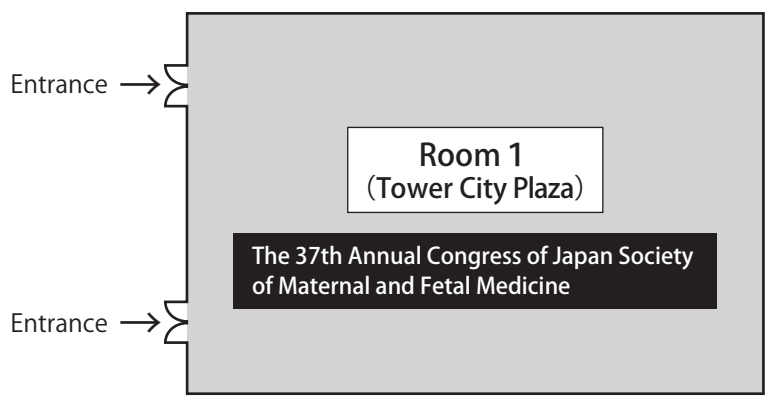

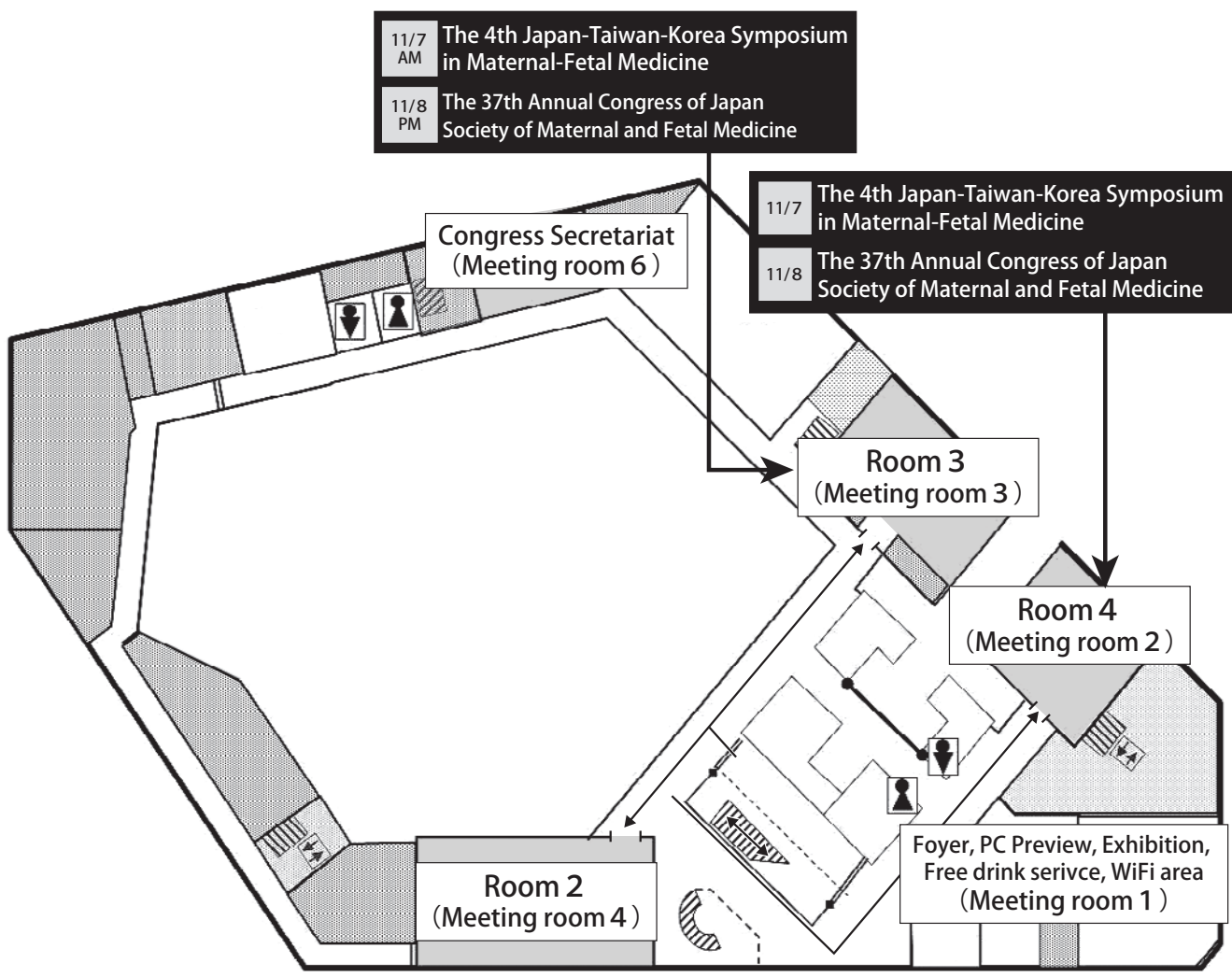
Bound for Huis Ten Bosch Station
